

Local Fishing Regulations

All wild steelhead and salmon must be released. Seasons are as follows:

Hayfork Creek from Hayfork to the mouth (that includes the portion at the house): from the Saturday before Memorial Day to March 31, catch and release only with barbless hooks.

South Fork of the Trinity upstream of the Hyampom bridge (that's the bridge over the South Fork about ½ mile upstream of the property): closed to all fishing, year-round.

South Fork of the Trinity from the Hyampom bridge downstream to Grouse Creek (about 10 miles downstream of Hyampom): from November 31 to March 31, catch and release with barbless hooks. This includes the portion of the Trinity nearest the house.

South Fork of the Trinity downstream from Grouse Creek: from the Saturday before Memorial Day to March 31, barbless hooks only. Bag limit of 1 hatchery trout or steelhead—these are marked by a healed adipose fin clip.
